Plot Synopsis: The internationally popular game is now a fun filled musical that brings the world's best-known suspects to life and invites the audience to help solve the mystery: who killed Mr. Boddy, in what room, and with what weapon. The audience receives forms to help them deduce the solution from clues given throughout the action. Three audience members choose from cards representing the potential murderers, weapons, and rooms. Only one hard nosed female detective is allowed to unravel the mayhem. Comic antics, witty lyrics, and a delightful score carry the investigation from room to room. Even after the culprit confesses, a surprise twist delights the audience.
