

The cold outside didn't stop eleven enthusiasts from showing up at Stuart's Opera House on January 26 in sweatshirts, sweaters, and scarves to get tips on "Making Paint Look Like What It Ain't" from tech workshop instructor Sandy Russell. Sandy's talents have been displayed for ABC Players in her portraits of Marcella Pinney Dowd and of Elwood P. Dowd and his invisible friend Harvey in *Harvey*, the statue of Jubilation T. Cornpone in *Li'l Abner*, and her work on sets for *The Odd Couple (Female Version)* and *An O'Henry Christmas*.


With ages ranging from a brand-new 9 to "I'm not telling," participants included Amy Abercrombie, Carol Ault, Rachelle Gorland, Ronda and Irie Green, Kristane Murray, Chris Neumann, Jim and Celeste Parsons, and Becca Robinson.

Sandy gave the group a quick introduction to color concepts, painting tools, and techniques. Then it was everyone for him/herself in trying out brushes, sponges, and paint. After starting with painting stone and brick walls on small pieces of cardboard, we moved on to a three-flat panel with the outline of an Italianate landscape with rolling hills, cloudless sky, trees, and a foreground stone balustrade and ivy-twined column. Even working at top speed, we couldn't complete all the detail, but the effect viewed from the house was very satisfactory.

The final technical workshop of the 2012-2013 season will be on props and prop management, presented by Ardelle Donohue, on March 23, 2013.
