

Auditions for Sensory-Friendly Animal Tales

Be a part of the very first ABC Players production for persons with sensory-processing disorders, developmental differences, autism, and others who struggle with the traditional audience set-up. This show will run between 30 and 45 minutes, featuring a series of songs about animals followed by a short musical play based on the Just So Story “The Elephant’s Child.” Performances will take place at 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. Saturday, April 8 (the Saturday before Easter Sunday), in # 30.

Auditions are scheduled for Feb. 11, 2023, from 2 to 4 p.m. in #30 Public Square. This is an ensemble show, with each actor having the possibility of being part of several different scenes. Actors from young performers (with some previous experience) to seniors are welcome to audition. Be ready to do some group movement, learn part of one of the songs, and read from the script. The director plans to hold two rehearsals per week (one rehearsal mid-week and one on the weekends) until the final week before performances. The rehearsal schedule will work around your commitments as much as possible, including obligations of those who have parts in *9 to 5 the Musical*.
